What's up with this fee on my receipt?

The fee is being assessed on products that will be a hazardous waste when disposed.

What does the fee pay for?

The fee will go toward offsetting the cost of properly collecting and recycling e-waste.

Why can't I just bring my old TV to the retailer where I bought my new TV?

E-waste cannot be dropped off at the store because they may not be equipped to properly manage the hazardous materials contained in electronic products. These hazardous materials, such as lead, can be harmful to the environment and human health if not disposed of properly.

Why should I recycle my e-waste?

When you eRecycle, you are:

- Helping conserve natural resources.
- Protecting human health and the environment.
- Keeping California safe and clean for generations to come.
- Complying with the law. (It is illegal to dispose of e-waste in the trash.)

How easy is it to eRecycle?

Recycling e-waste has never been easier! There are hundreds of locations throughout the state where electronic devices can be conveniently dropped-off and most of them are free of charge.
